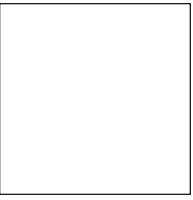

Rob's Results

Reducing the Tax Burden on Working Families and Businesses in Pennsylvania.

- Introduced legislation to roll back the double tax on cell phones by repealing the Gross receipts tax.
- Voted to hold state spending increases to the rate of inflation, setting aside half of the surplus revenues in the state's Rainy Day Fund for use in times of economic necessity and half in a new Taxpayer Fairness Fund to reduce the Personal Income Tax.

Protecting Our Environment

- Voted for Growing Greener II, which provides \$625 million over 6 years for a variety of environmental and conservation projects, including watershed protection, mine reclamation, and brownfields cleanup.
- Voted for \$10 million in funding for advanced energy projects and up to \$2.5 million annually for a sales tax holiday for energy efficient appliances.
- Voted for \$217 million for state parks and forests and open space conservation.

Reforming Government

- Introduced Senate Bill 5, a comprehensive election reform package to prevent fraud and ensure that Pennsylvania elections are conducted fairly with no partisan advantages given to anyone.
- Voted to extend the deadline for receipt of absentee ballots cast by military voters serving abroad.
- Introduced legislation to reform the way the state administers, funds, enforces and coordinates Pennsylvania's conservation efforts.
- Called for reform of the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency to ensure that state funding be used to make higher education more affordable to students who need financial assistance.

Working to Ensure Quality and Affordable Healthcare

- Introduced Senate Bill 671 to help reduce the high cost of health insurance for small businesses.
- Voted for legislation to help keep doctors in Pennsylvania by extending the MCARE Abatement program for physicians.
- Introduced Senate Bill 460 to create a cancer drug repository for the donation of unused cancer drugs.

Rob's Values

- **Property Tax Reform:** Lower the unfair real estate tax burden on local property owners and reform the method of funding public education.
- **Health Care:** Maintaining and improving access to high quality health care services.
- **Traffic/Sprawl:** As our communities continue to grow we must look at bold initiatives that improve new roads and transit systems while improving the existing infrastructure.
- **Environment:** Strengthen the future of our communities through comprehensive planning, preserving open space and controlling urban sprawl.
- **Education:** I believe we must do a better job of educating our children in order to compete in the 21st century workforce. I support offering more college aid to make college more affordable and restructuring primary and secondary education to meet the demands of new job skills.
- **First Responders:** Providing our firefighters with the equipment they need to respond to emergencies.

Rob's Experience

- Elected to his first term in the Pennsylvania Senate in November 2002.
- He is Chairman of the Communications and Technology Committee, and is a member of the Aging and Youth, Consumer Protection & Professional Licensure, Finance, and Local Government Committees.
- Rob serves on the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee, the Children's Trust Fund Board, the Joint Legislative Air and Water Pollution Control and Conservation Committee and the Majority Policy Committee.
- Rob presently works for Bentley Systems, Inc., an engineering software and technology company based in Pennsylvania.
- As Governor Tom Ridge's Deputy Secretary of Transportation, Rob was responsible for improving the operation and efficiency of PennDOT's 5,000-employee highway maintenance workforce.
- Rob also held the position of Chief Operating Officer of the Team Pennsylvania Economic Development Organization.
- As President of the PENJERDEL Council, an organization devoted to the Delaware Valley's economic and environmental prosperity, Rob was involved in numerous policy initiatives related to our region's environment, water supply, land use planning, and trails.
- He received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Allegheny College and a Master's degree in Government Administration from the University of Pennsylvania. In 1997, he was selected by Governor Tom Ridge to attend the program for Senior Executives in State Government at Harvard University.
